Get Creative at the Music Box

The Music Box at Stevenson College Edinburgh is launching five new courses to help develop your creative talent, which start from 23rd April.

The courses in video production, scriptwriting for beginners, creative sound engineering, digital sound engineering and the Saturday Rock Academy are all located in the Music Box's state-of-the-art facilities in the West of Edinburgh.

For those who enjoy watching movies and would like to try their hand at making programmes the **Video Production Course** will help develop the basic skills to get you started. For those with a story to tell and ambitions to write for film, TV or radio, the **Scriptwriting for Beginners Course** will help with structure, idea generation and character development.

For would-be Sound Engineers or Sound Technicians the **Creative Sound Engineering Course** will provide the opportunity to record live bands and work on studio technique. For performers, DJs or composers who would like to enhance their computer-based programming skills, the **Digital Audio Skills Course** will help.

The **Saturday Rock Academy** is for rock musicians whose performance skills could benefit from some polishing.

The courses are run either on Saturday mornings or Tuesday or Thursday evenings and last for just 10 weeks. Prices range from £150 to £250 and all courses are eligible for an ILA.
