Lothian Step Up (2002 – 2005)

The Lothian Transition Programme (STEP UP) was a 3 year multi-annual partnership between Career Development Edinburgh and Lothians, City of Edinburgh Council, East Lothian Council, Midlothian Council, West Lothian Council, the four local Further Education Colleges and Scottish Enterprises Edinburgh and Lothians (SEEL). The partnership benefited from experience and knowledge gained through Employment Youthstart and other ESF programmes. The partnership aimed to:

- Implement an enhanced curriculum with an Education for Work focus for S3/S4 schools in Edinburgh, East Lothian and Midlothian
- Reduce exclusion by promoting positive learning cultures and use specialist provision through small class sizes
- Provide targeted provision within a flexible framework that allows elements of the programme to be customised to the needs of each young person.
